



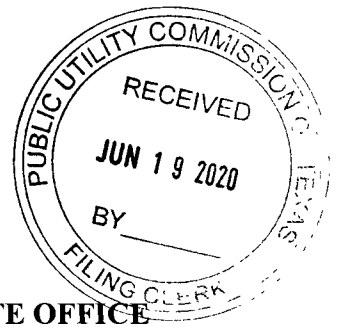

SOAH ORDER NO. 5  
DECLASSIFYING PORTIONS OF DOCUMENTS

On June 12, 2020, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Declassify Portions of Confidential Documents. On April 26, 2019, C Willow Water company (C-Willow) filed confidential answers to Staff's First Request for Information (RFI). The motion represents that C-Willow's responses were filed entirely confidentially but only portions of the documents actually contained confidential information. Staff attached to the motion a redacted version of C-Willow's RFI responses, which redacts all information that could potentially be considered confidential, including customers' social security numbers, drivers' license information, customer information not related to particular address in question, and the phone numbers of any person not a party to the proceeding. The motion did not indicate the other parties' position on the motion. Michael E. Moore and C-Willow did not file responses.

Under the circumstances, the ALJ finds that the motion has merit and should be granted. **THEREFORE**, the motion is **GRANTED**. The portions of the C-Willow's RFI responses that do not contain pertinent personal information are declassified, and the redacted version of C-Willow's RFI responses may be presented at the telephonic hearing scheduled for June 23, 2020. All parties must pre-file exhibits before the date of the hearing.
