ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of the City of Floresville filed on February 26, 2019, to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 20279 in Wilson County.

Commission Staff recommends the application be found administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review. The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before April 29, 2019, the City of Floresville must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Spencer English's March 28, 2019 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before May 29, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
