



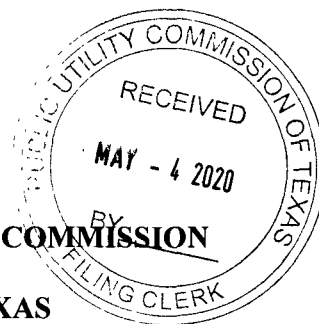

GRANTING EXTENSION AND AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's May 1, 2020 filing requesting an extension, and to amend the procedural schedule. Commission Staff requests additional time to receive and review updated mapping information from City of Floresville.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants the extension request and requires City of Floresville file to file revised mapping information on or before May 26, 2020.

The administrative law judge amends the procedural schedule as follows:

Event	Date
Deadline for Floresville to file revised mapping information	May 26, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Floresville for review and consent	June 25, 2020
Deadline for Floresville to file signed consent forms with the Commission	July 9, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	July 16, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to jointly file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	July 23, 2020
