**COMMISSION STAFF’S COMMENTS ON SUFFICIENCY
OF REVISED MAPPING INFORMATION**

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files these Comments on the Sufficiency of the Revised Mapping Information. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 26, 2019, the City of Floresville (Floresville) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10688, in Wilson County, Texas. The requested area includes approximately 4,201 acres and 171 connections.

On November 20, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 18, requiring Staff to file comments on the sufficiency of the revised mapping information by December 11, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. COMMENTS

Staff has reviewed Floresville’s first revised map, filed on November 12, 2020, and its second revised map, filed on November 30, 2020, and recommends that the revised mapping information be found deficient. Floresville’s revised map, filed on November 12, 2020, depicts the proposed service area and locations of customers receiving or requesting service who are located outside Floresville’s city limits, as required by Order No. 15. However, Floresville’s second revised map, filed on November 30, 2020, does not clearly depict other information required by Order No. 15, including the boundaries of Floresville’s city limits, the boundaries of Floresville’s extraterritorial jurisdiction, and city, county, state, and federal roads, highways, and other similar routes.

Staff requests that Floresville be required to file revised mapping information, identical to the mapping information filed in Docket No. 49262 on September 9, 2020 (Interchange Item No.

42),¹ representing the correct docket no. (Docket No. 49263) and the correct proceeding (Proposed Water CCN No. 10688), in accordance with Order No. 15. Staff requests that Floresville be required to file the revised mapping information by December 28, 2020, and that Staff be required to file supplemental comments on the sufficiency of the revised mapping information by January 11, 2021.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ issue an order consistent with Staff's recommendations.
