ORDER NO. 20 FINDING MAPPING SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING PROPOSED ORDER

This Order addresses Commission Staff's December 29, 2020 comments on sufficiency of revised mapping information. The administrative law judge finds the City of Floresville's first revised map filed on November 12, 2020 and the third revised map filed on December 11, 2020 to be sufficient.

By January 12, 2021, the parties must file a Proposed Order that is formatted like, and contains a level of detail similar to, the Proposed Order filed in Docket No. 45489 on February 22, 2019.¹ For each proposed finding of fact, the parties should include a footnote reference to the specific document(s) in the evidentiary record that supports the finding.
