**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE; REQUIRING
NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of Jackson Water Supply Corporation, filed on February 27, 2019, to amend a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Smith County. Jackson WSC filed supplements to the application on April 26, 2019, May 17, 2019, and July 1, 2019.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete, directs Jackson WSC to provide notice of the application as described in Commission Staff's July 26, 2019, supplemental recommendation and attached July 25, 2019, memorandum of Emily Sears, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Jackson WSC to file signed affidavits that the notice was provided, along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties, and published in a newspaper of general circulation	September 16, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of Jackson WSC filing proof of completed notice
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
