COMMISSION STAFF’S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

COMES NOW Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 4, files this, Commission Staff’s Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice. Staff recommends that the notice be found sufficient. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 27, 2019, the Jackson Water Supply Corporation (Jackson WSC) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10763, in Smith County, Texas. The requested area includes approximately 4,000 acres and 110 connections.

On July 29, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 4, wherein she ordered Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice within 10 days of Jackson WSC filing proof of completed notice. Jackson WSC filed proof of completed notice on September 13, 2019. Staff apologizes for this filing not being within the 10 days given.

II. SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

Staff recommends that the proof of completed notice filed by Jackson WSC on September 13, 2019, be found sufficient.
