ORDER NO. 5 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Jackson Water Supply Corporation. On September 13, 2019, Jackson filed the affidavit of Travis Reed, Jackson's authorized representative, attesting that notice was provided to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on August 20, 2019. Jackson also filed the publisher's affidavit of Alyssa Hankins, advertising director of the *Tyler Morning Telegraph*, attesting to publication of notice on August 26, 2019, and September 2, 2019.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and directs Commission Staff to file, by October 9, 2019, a procedural schedule for continued processing.
