COMMISSION STAFF’S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Proposed Procedural Schedule and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 27, 2019, Jackson Water Supply Corporation (Jackson WSC) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10763, in Smith County, Texas. The requested area includes approximately 4,184 acres and 63 current customers. Order No. 5, issued September 30, 2019, found Jackson WSC’s notice sufficient directed Staff to file a procedural schedule for the continued processing of this docket by October 9, 2019. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In response to Order No. 5, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Notice completed	September 2, 2019
Deadline for intervention	October 2, 2019
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Applicant for review and consent	November 1, 2019
Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	November 15, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	November 22, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	December 3, 2019

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order adopting the procedural schedule proposed above.




