The purpose of this letter is to provide the first request for information from the Public Utility Commission of Texas. The information requested is below and addressed.

Staff 1-1

Please provide a detailed map(s) identifying the location of all the following items:

- a. Boundary of Jackson WSC's existing water CCN No. 10763;
- b. Boundary of the requested areas in the current docket;
- c. Boundaries of city limits and extraterritorial jurisdiction;
- d. Potential customers requesting service within the requested areas; and
- e. Existing customers within the requested area.

The map titled Jackson WSC CCN Request for Information: Staff 1-1 is attached.

Staff 1-2

Please provide a detailed map identifying the location of the following items:

- a. Existing water or sewer facilities for production, transmission, distribution, collection, and treatment within the boundaries of the existing CCN;
- b. Existing water or sewer facilities for production, transmission, distribution, collection, and treatment within the boundaries of the requested areas;
- c. Proposed water or sewer facilities for production, transmission, distribution, collection, and treatment within the boundaries of the existing CCN;
- d. Proposed water or sewer facilities for production, transmission, distribution, collection, and treatment within the boundaries of the requested areas;

Note: Facilities should be identified on subdivision plats, engineering planning maps, or detailed maps. Please use color coding to distinguish different types of facilities and boundaries.

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Staff 1-3

Please provide a copy of each map that Jackson WSC uses to respond to RFI 1 and 2 in the following forms:

- a. Hard copy, full-sized, and rendered to scaled; and

Staff 1-4

Provide any requests for service to support the need for service in the requested area.

This question was answered in a letter to the PUC that was received by the PUC Filing Clerk on July 1, 2019. This letter was in response to a PUC Interoffice Memorandum dated May 23, 2019 requesting information, which included the same question. The question was answered as follows: "In regards to 'need of service' for Area A1, the WSC does actually already serve customers in this area, see attached system maps. The WSC has received additional requests for service in this area but no formal petition. Area A2 does not have existing customers but has had a formal petition for water service." The system maps were attached to the letter received by the PUC showing the locations of the customers already served in the area. This information is also available as an attached map for this letter titled, "Jackson WSC CCN Request for Information: Staff 1-1."

Staff 1-5

Provide construction approvals letter(s) from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for any facilities that are necessary to provide service in the requested area. This includes any upgrades to the existing water plant and the construction of the distribution system(s). If facility plans have been submitted to TCEQ, but not yet approved, please provide documents demonstrating when the plans were submitted.

This question was also answered in a letter to the PUC that was received by the PUC Filing Clerk on July 1, 2019. This letter was in response to a PUC Interoffice Memorandum dated May 23, 2019 requesting information, which included this same question. The question was answered as follows: "Construction is not necessary to serve future connections in the proposed service areas A1 and A2. Jackson WSC has ample capacity in source water, high service pump capacity, pressure tank capacity, and total storage capacity to take on additional service connections. We simply wanted to mention that Jackson WSC is in the process of planning and design on a new water well as an example of their proactiveness to prepare for growth. Please see attached TCEQ minimum capacity table illustrating sufficient capacity for all TCEQ required capacities." This table was attached to the letter received by the PUC.
