**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND
DEFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Jackson Water Supply Corporation's supplemental application information filed on April 26, 2019 and May 17, 2019. On May 24, 2019, Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge find the application remains deficient and provide Jackson Water an opportunity to cure the deficiencies provided in the supplemental recommendation.

The ALJ finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.


On or before July 1, 2019, Jackson Water must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies identified and described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the requested supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Jackson Water must not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before July 31, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
