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APPLICATION OF YANCEY WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION TO AMEND A WATER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN MEDINA AND FRIO COUNTIES

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COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 3, files this Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 28, 2019, the Yancey Water Supply Corporation (Yancey WSC) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11463, in Medina and Frio Counties, Texas. The requested area includes approximately 224,705 acres and 1,764 connections.

On May 30, 2019, Order No. 3 was issued, establishing a deadline of July 15, 2019 for Yancey WSC to file proof of notice and also establishing a deadline of 10 days after Yancey WSC's filing of proof of notice for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE

As of July 19, 2019, Yancey WSC has not yet filed proof of notice. Therefore, Staff recommends that notice be deemed incomplete. Staff recommends that Yancey WSC be given an opportunity to cure and be ordered to file proof of notice by August 20, 2019 and that Staff be given a deadline of 10 days after Yancey's filing of proof of notice to file supplemental recommendation on notice.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's deficiency recommendation, Staff does not propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation for sufficiency of notice.

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IV. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendation.
