COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 4, files this Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 28, 2019, the Yancey Water Supply Corporation (Yancey WSC) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11463, in Medina and Frio Counties, Texas. The requested area includes approximately 224,705 acres and 1,764 connections.

On July 23, 2019, Order No. 4 was issued, establishing a deadline of August 20, 2019 for Yancey WSC to file proof of notice and also establishing a deadline of 10 days after Yancey WSC's filing of proof of notice for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE

Staff has reviewed Yancey WSC's proof of notice filed on July 29, 2019 and recommends that it be found sufficient.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Because Staff recommends the notice be found sufficient, Staff proposes the following schedule:

Event	Date
Notice Completed	July 3, 2019
Deadline for Intervention	August 2, 2019

Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Applicant for review and consent	October 1, 2019
Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	October 15, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	October 22, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	October 29, 2019

IV. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendation.


