ORDER NO. 7 REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the joint motion to amend procedural schedule filed by Yancey Water Supply Corporation and Commission Staff on September 30, 2019.¹ Yancey Water and Commission Staff need additional time to review mapping issues related to this docket.

The administrative law judge grants the motion and the following procedural schedule applies:

| If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application | November 21, 2019 |
| If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to jointly file a proposed order containing detailed, legally sufficient findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs ² | December 3, 2019 |

¹ Yancey Water and Commission Staff do not explain whether the intervenors in this case oppose the motion. In all future motions, the parties are reminded to advise the ALJ as to all other parties' positions on the motion.

² Given the size of the area to be added to Yancey's certificate of convenience and necessity, the ALJ believes it is appropriate for this matter to be decided by the Commission, not the ALJ. Therefore, a proposed order, not a proposed notice of approval, is required.
