**ORDER NO. 19
DENYING MOTION TO ADMIT ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE**

In Order No. 16 filed on August 12, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) admitted into the evidentiary record of this proceeding, among other items, the map and certificate that purportedly had been attached Commission Staff's corrected amended final recommendation filed on August 7, 2020.

Subsequently, while working on this matter, the ALJ discovered that no map and certificate were attached to Commission Staff's August 7, 2020 filing, as that document appeared in the Commission's interchange. Accordingly, in Order No. 17 filed on September 10, 2020, the ALJ directed the parties to file, and move for admission of, the map and certificate.

On September 24, 2020, Commission Staff explained that, in fact, they had included the map and certificate with their August 7, 2020 filing and the map and certificate were included in the native files on the Commission's interchange, however, the map and certificate were inadvertently not scanned onto the interchange. Commission Staff further reported that they had worked with the Commission's Central Records department to correct this discrepancy, such that the map and certificate had been scanned and now appear on the interchange as attachments to Commission Staff's corrected amended final recommendation filed on August 7, 2020.

On October 26, 2020, the parties again moved for admission of the map and certificate. Because the map and certificate were already admitted in Order No. 16 and the inaccuracies with respect to Commission Staff's August 7, 2020 filing have now been cured on the interchange, it is not necessary to re-admit the map and certificate. Therefore, the parties' October 26, 2020 motion to admit the map and certificate is denied.
