ORDER NO. 16
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application filed by the City of Fort Worth for a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Tarrant, Denton, Wise, and Parker counties and the sufficiency of the notice. On September 3, 2020, City of Fort Worth filed the affidavit of Christopher P. Harder, director, who attested that notice and a map was mailed on August 11, 2020, to neighboring utilities, counties, cities, and affected parties. Also, Fort Worth filed a publishers' affidavit attesting to the publication of notice on August 13, and 20, 2020, in the *Star-Telegram*, a newspaper of general circulation in Tarrant, Denton, Parker and Wise counties. On September 14, 2020, Commission Staff recommended that the notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient. The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
