**ORDER NO. 19
GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW INTERVENTION**

On August 23, 2019, Undine Texas Environmental, LLC moved to intervene in this proceeding, asserting that it was likely to be adversely affected by the certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) sought by the City of Fort Worth. The city asked the administrative law judge (ALJ) to defer ruling on the motion to intervene because the city planned to amend its application in such a way that, argued the city, would moot Undine's concerns about the application.

Thereafter, the ALJ repeatedly deferred ruling on Undine's motion to intervene, and repeatedly asked Undine to advise whether it continued to seek intervention.

By motion filed October 15, 2020, Undine confirms that it no longer wishes to intervene. The ALJ deems Undine's prior motion to intervene to be withdrawn and Undine is not a party to this case.
