**ORDER NO. 20
GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW INTERVENTION**

On August 31, 2020, the City of Weatherford moved to intervene in this proceeding, asserting that it was likely to be adversely affected by the certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) sought by the City of Fort Worth. In Order No. 15 filed on September 14, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) granted the motion.

By motion filed on December 7, 2020, Weatherford asks to withdraw as a party to this proceeding. Weatherford and Fort Worth have worked together to resolve Weatherford's concerns about Fort Worth's application.

The ALJ grants the motion to withdraw and Weatherford is no longer a party in this docket.
