Notice of Appearance and Motion to Intervene of HMW Special Utility District of Harris and

Comes now the HMW Special Utility District of Harris and Montgomery Counties("HMW"), filing its Notice of Appearance and Motion to Intervene under Public Utility Commission("PUC") Rules 22.103 and 22.104, and states as follows:

I.

The undersigned counsel enters his appearance on behalf of HMW.

II.

HMW holds Certificate of Convenience No. 10342(the "CCN"), a portion of which the Applicant seeks to decertify.

III.

The proposed decertification is defective on its face, as well as unlawful, and thus prejudicial to HMW's rights under applicable law.

IV.

Further, and alternatively, the application facially asserts that it seeks to deprive HMW of a vested property right, i.e. the rights conferred by the CCN as to the area proposed to be decertified.


V.

Accordingly, HMW has a right to intervene in this proceeding under PUC Rules 22.103 and 22.104, and to assert in full its rights thereunder and other applicable law.


