**ORDER NO. 14
MOTION TO DISMISS FOLLOWING REMAND**

By Order filed July 16, 2020, the Commission remanded this matter to Docket Management to address the issue of whether the Commission should dismiss it without prejudice under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.181.

In light of the Commission's discussion, the administrative law judge (ALJ) is of the opinion that the application in this matter should be dismissed under 16 TAC § 22.181(d)(8), because it fails to state a claim for which relief can be granted. Under 16 TAC § 22.181(a) and (e), dismissal of a proceeding may be made upon the motion of the ALJ. This Order constitutes such a motion. The basis for dismissal and the material facts supporting the motion are summarized in the Commission's Order Remanding to Docket Management filed on July 16, 2020, which is incorporated herein by reference.

If Green Valley Special Utility District wishes to respond to the motion, it must do so within 20 days of its receipt of this Order.

Any response from Commission Staff is due by August 21, 2020.
