**ORDER NO. 6  
FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND  
NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the petition of Frost Bank National Bank, as trustee of the Freeman Educational Foundation, to amend the City of San Marcos' water certificate of convenience and necessity in Hays County by expedited release.

The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively complete and the notice sufficient. The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for City of San Marcos and intervenors to file a response to the administratively complete petition	September 18, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition	September 25, 2019
Deadline for Frost Bank to file a reply to both the City of San Marcos' response and Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition	October 2, 2019
Sixty-day administrative approval	November 12, 2019 <sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Sixty (60) days from the application date of being administratively complete (September 11, 2019) is Sunday, November 10, 2019 and the PUC will be closed for Veterans Day, Monday, November 11, 2019. Therefore, the final decision deadline advances to the next business day, Tuesday, November 12, 2019.
