

Dear Commissioners:

In accordance with TWC § 13.254(a-5) and Section 24.245(1) of Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code (the "Commission rules"), a landowner of 25 of more access of land located in a CCN may request streamlined, expedited release from a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity "CCN." Frost Bank National Bank, as Trustee of the Freeman Educational Foundation, is the landowner of more than 25 acres; the property is not receiving water service from the current CCN holder, the City of San Marcos; and, at least part of the tract of land is located in the current CCN holder's certificated service area and in Hays County, which is a qualifying county.

Exhibit A is a copy of the recorded Warranty Deed that describes the property for exclusion from the City of San Marcos Water. The property includes approximately 476 acres of land within CCN No. 10298, and the property is located in Hays County a qualifying County under Section 24.113(1). Exhibit B, attached as a CD-ROM, is a digital mapping data in a shapefile (.shp) formatted to PUC specifications for the area that the PUC must remove from the City of San Marcos Water CCN Area. Exhibit C, attached, is a copy of the U.S. Postal Service Certified Mail Receipt evidencing that mailing of a copy of this patition to the City of San Marcos, the current CCN holder. Exhibit D is a sealed, metes & bounds description of the property. Exhibit E is the Commission's water CCN map showing the location of the property within the San Marcos water CCN.
