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**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING PETITION INCOMPLETE AND**  
**ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the petition of Frost Bank National Bank, as trustee of the Freeman Educational Foundation (Frost Bank) filed on March 22, 2019, requesting to amend the City of San Marcos' water certificate of convenience and necessity in Hays County by expedited release. On April 22, 2019, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the administrative completeness and proposed notice.

The petition does not contain all of the materials required by 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.245(m), specifically the map and digital data provided with the petition are not consistent with data provided by Hays County Appraisal District, nor with the metes and bounds summary.

On or before May 22, 2019, Frost Bank must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Commission Staff's recommendation.

On or before June 21, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
