STATUS REPORT REGARDING SETTLEMENT

El Paso Water Control and Improvement District No. 4 ("District"), the Mesa del Norte Ratepayers ("Ratepayers") and Commission Staff ("Staff") file this Status Report Regarding Settlement.

On November 12, 2019, the parties to this proceeding participated in a mediation led by the mediators from the State Office of Administrative Hearings. At the conclusion of and as a result of that mediation, the District and Ratepayers reached a Settlement Agreement intended to fully resolve this dispute.1 The Settlement Agreement has already been executed by legal counsel for the District and legal counsel for the Ratepayers. The Settlement Agreement still needs to be approved by the Board of Directors of the District (undersigned counsel for the District expects such approval by no later than November 28, 2019), ratified by the Mesa del Norte Ratepayers' organization, and fully executed by both the District and the Ratepayers.

Staff separately states that it has conferred with the parties and has learned that they have entered into a settlement agreement. Staff is unopposed to the settlement, but was not a participant in the final settlement agreement.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This document memorializes the settlement between the Mesa del Norte Ratepayers ("Ratepayers") and the LI Paso County Water Control and Improvement District No. 4 ("District") of an appeal of out-of-district rates charged by the District. The parties agree that they have voluntarily come to this agreement and that this document and the attached Exhibit A contains all agreed-to terms.

- Effective January 1, 2020, the rate differential between Ratepayers and in-district customers ("rate differential") will be 1.4.
- 2 This rate differential of 1.4 will remain in effect for four years from January 1, 2020, or until the date the Ratepayers are fully served with water and wastewater by Lower Valley Water District, whichever is earlier.
- 3 No rate increases for Ratepayers will be made based on the 2015 Willdan rate study, including any annual 5% rate increase.
- By January 1, 2020, the District will provide a \$160 credit to each of the Ratepayers' accounts.
- 5. Contemporaneously with the execution of this Agreement, the District will execute an addendum to the November 2019 Interlocal Agreement between the District and the Lower Valley Water District with the language attached to this document as Exhibit A. The

Addendum to the Interlocal Agreement will be executed by the District by November 28.

2019. The parties understand that this Addendum will be subject to agreement by the Lower Valley Water District.

6. Ratepayers will withdraw their petition within five days of the full execution of both this Agreement and the Addendum to Interlocal Agreement.

\$ ADDENDUM TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN \$ THE LOWER VALLEY WATER DISTRICT AND THE EL.

COUNTY OF EL PASO

\$ PASO COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND \$ IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO, 4 RELATING TO THE \$ PROVISION OF WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICES \$ TO THE MESA DEL NORTE SUBDIVISION \$

This addendum to the November 2019 Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the Lower Valley Water District ("I VWD") and the I I Paso County Water Control and Improvement District No. 4 (the "Labens District")

WHEREAS LVWD and the Fabens District agreed to a November 2019 Interlocal Agreement in which LVWD agreed to pay \$50 multiplied by the number of active water connections within the Mesa del Norte subdivision per month to Fabens in exchange for Fabens posting a \$50 credit to each of those active accounts pursuant to the terms of the Agreement, and

WHEREAS the residents of Mesa del Norte subdivision (MDN Residents) pay taxes to I VWD and out-of-district rates for water and wastewater to I abens District which are higher than in-district rates and have been higher since 2011

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, and intending to be bound hereby, LVWD and the Labens District agree as follows:

- MDN Residents shall continue to pay out-of-district rates to the Fabens District for the delivery of water and wastewater, until such time as LVWD can assume service
- 1.2 MDN Residents shall continue to pay taxes to LVWD during the time that the Labens District provides water and wastewater services to MDN Residents.
- 1.3 MDN Residents shall have the legal right to receive a monthly credit to their water utility bills as described in Sections 2.1-2.4 of the Agreement. Sections 3.7 and 3.8 of the Agreement do not bar the MDN Residents' legal right to bring an enforcement action to receive these credits.
- 1.4 MDN Residents shall have the legal right to demand that I VWD pay all amounts due to Fabens District as described in Section 1.2 of the Agreement. Sections 3.7 and 3.8 of the Agreement do not bar the MDN Residents' legal right to bring an enforcement action to demand that I VWD pay the payments due to Labens District.
