**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the March 27, 2019, application of Nerro Supply LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC (applicants) for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Brazos, Burleson, Chambers, Montgomery, Robertson, and Walker counties. In addition to the sale and transfer, Undine requests to add approximately 399 acres in Burleson and Montgomery counties and to decertify approximately 85 acres in Burleson county. On April 26, 2019, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the administrative completeness and proposed notice of the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner and form described in Spencer English's memorandum dated April 26, 2019. The following procedural schedule applies:


Deadline for applicants to file signed affidavits that notice was provided, along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	June 10, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of applicants filing proof of completed notice

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Deadline for affected persons to file motions to intervene; deadline to request a hearing on the merits	30 days after notice is issued
