ORDER NO. 6 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of Nerro Supply LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC (applicants), filed on March 27, 2019, for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Chambers, Harris, and Walker counties. On August 8, 2019 and August 27, 2019, Undine filed affidavits of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities and affected parties, indicating that notice of application was mailed on July 26, 2019 and August 27, 2019. In Order No. 5 issued on August 20, 2019, the administrative law judge determined that publication of notice would not be required.

The administrative law judge finds notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale	October 25, 2019
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on the approval of the sale	December 9, 2019
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed. See Docket No. 49169, Order No. 4 for details	December 9, 2019
120-day deadline for Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	January 6, 2020
