FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of Nerro Supply, LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC filed on March 27, 2020, for the sale, transfer, or merger of certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Chambers, Harris, and Walker Counties. The applicants filed closing documents on July 6, 2020.

The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation sufficient. However, the transfer of certificate rights requested in this application is not complete until the application receives final approval. The applicants also filed documentation showing that all customer deposits to the current transaction have been addressed.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicants for review and consent.	August 20, 2020
Deadline for applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	August 27, 2020
Deadline for parties to jointly file a proposed Notice of Approval, including proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law and ordering paragraphs	September 21, 2020
