**ORDER NO. 8
SOLICITING JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE AND PROPOSED ORDER**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the transaction filed on January 23, 2020.

Evidence Needed to Approve Sale and Allow Transaction to Proceed

The administrative law judge requires an evidentiary record in order to approve the sale and allow the transaction to proceed. The parties must submit a joint motion to admit evidence, as provided by the procedural schedule from Order No. 7 filed on January 8, 2020. The requested motion should include, but is not limited to, a request for admission of:

1. The applicants' application;
2. The applicants' proof of notice and supporting documentation;
3. The applicants' responses to requests for information, if any; and
4. Commission Staff's recommendation on the sale.

Proposed Order Approving Sale and Allowing Transaction to Proceed

Further, the parties must submit a proposed order approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed, as provided by Order No. 7. The requested proposed order should be modeled, with a comparable level of detail, on Order No. 9 from Docket No. 48680.

The requested joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order must be filed no later than March 24, 2020.
