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

**MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION**

COMES NOW, Las Lomas Municipal Utility District No. 4A of Kaufman County (formerly, Las Lomas Municipal Utility District No. 4 of Kaufman County) and Las Lomas Municipal Utility District No. 4B of Kaufman County (collectively, the “Applicants”), and files this Motion to Withdraw Application, and in support thereof, respectfully shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On March 28, 2019, Applicants submitted an application for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of water facilities and certificate rights in Kaufman County.

On April 3, 2019, the Commission Administrative Law Judge (the “ALJ”) issued Order No. 1, providing May 1, 2019 as the deadline for the Commission Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application.

On May 3, 2019, the ALJ issued Order No. 2, finding the application incomplete and deficient. In Order No. 2, the ALJ stated that the Applicants must supplement the application on or before May 31, 2019 to cure the deficiencies described in the May 1, 2019 memorandum by Roshan Pokhrel. Order No. 2 also provided July 1, 2019 as the Commission Staff’s deadline to

file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule.

On June 4, 2019, the ALJ issued Order No. 3, granting the Applicants an extension of time to file its supplemental application. In Order No. 3, the ALJ stated that the Applicants must file the supplemental application by June 21, 2019 and the Commission Staff must file its recommendation, proposed notice and procedural schedule by July 22, 2019.

On July 22, 2019, the ALJ issued Order No. 4, granting the Commission Staff an extension of time to file its recommendations on the Applicants' supplemental application. In Order No. 4, the ALJ stated that the Commission Staff must file its recommendation, proposed notice and procedural schedule by August 12, 2019.

The Applicants now wish to withdraw the application without prejudice. Commission Rule 16 Texas Administrative Code Section 22.181(g) states that a party that filed the application may withdraw it without prejudice at any time before that party has presented its direct case. Therefore, Applicants filed this Motion timely.

## **II. APPLICANTS' MOTION TO WITHDRAW**

The Applicants respectfully ask that the ALJ authorize the Applicants to withdraw without prejudice the application for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of water facilities and certificate rights in Kaufman County.


