#### ANSWER:

Please refer to Schedule H.I.J and CA.

The amounts for Vegetation Management are included in FERC Accts 5710 and 5930 for Maintenance for Overhead Lines and FERC Accts 5690 and 5910 for Maintenance of Structures for substation mowing and herbicide spraying.

In WP II-I-1.2, FERC Acct 5710 is functionalized to Transmission, FERC Acct 5930 is functionalized to Distribution, and FERC Acct 5690 and 5910 are both functionalized to Transmission and Distribution.

In Schedule II-I-TRAN, FERC Accts 5710, 5690 and 5910 are allocated to the rate classes by the D2 allocator.

In Schedule II-I-DIST, FERC Acct 5930 is allocated to the rate classes by the A365 allocator, FERC Acct 5690 is allocated to the rate classes by the D3 allocator, and FERC Acct 5910 is allocated to the rate classes by the A360-2 allocator.
