**ORDER NO. 1  
REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

This Order addresses AEP Texas Inc.'s November 25, 2019, compliance filing related to the bill credit ordered in Docket No. 49402.<sup>1</sup> As a condition of the approval of the transfer of distribution assets in the McAllen and Mission area of Hidalgo County from Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC to AEP Texas, AEP Texas was ordered to provide a one-time bill credit equally allocated to each of the transitioned retail customers in the amount of \$90,000, to be applied during the effective billing month of January 2020. To accomplish the credit, AEP Texas seeks approval of AEP Texas rider STC – Sharyland transition credit (rider STC). AEP Texas stated that it will provide notice of this proceeding to all parties that participated in Docket No. 49402 and to each retail electric provider registered to provide service in Texas.

By December 11, 2019, Commission Staff must file a recommendation regarding AEP Texas's compliance filing, proposed method of notice, and propose a procedural schedule for processing.
