ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the April 12, 2019 application of Legend Bank, Inc. and Ray Harlow for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Angelina County. On May 7, 2019, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before June 6, 2019, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the May 7, 2019 memorandum by Fred Bednarski. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before July 8, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
