SOAH ORDER NO. 5
GRANTING MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE AND REMAND;
AND DISMISSING CASE FROM SOAH DOCKET

On August 14, 2019, Entergy Texas, Inc. (Entergy), staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), the cities (Cities)¹, and Texas Industrial Energy Consumers (TIEC) (collectively, Parties) filed an Unopposed Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand to the Commission. The Parties noted that a settlement has been reached and there are no disputed issues and a hearing is not required in this proceeding. Entergy also included a proposed order with the settlement agreement and stipulation.
