SOAH ORDER NO. 5
GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE
AND REMAND; AND DISMISSING CASE FROM SOAH DOCKET

On July 31, 2019, Southwestern Public Service Company (“SPS”) and staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) jointly filed an unopposed stipulation (Stipulation) with attachments, resolving all substantive issues in this proceeding, and filed a Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand to the Commission. 
Remand to the Commission
