II. NOTICE OF HEARING

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) will convene a hearing at 9:30 a.m. on July 10, 2019, at the State Office of Administrative Hearings, William P. Clements Building, 300 W. 15th Street, Fourth Floor, Austin, Texas. The parties are advised that they must clear security at the security desk in the foyer of the Clements Building and they should allow sufficient time to complete the process.

III. SUFFICIENCY OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE

On May 31, 2019, Staff filed comments recommending that EPE's application and notice be deemed sufficient. The ALJ finds EPE's application and notice of the application sufficient.

IV. EXTENDING DEADLINE

The parties requested that the 180-day deadline in 16 Texas Administrative Code § 25.182(d)(9)(E) be extended as a result of parties' conflicts with other commitment in reaching a proposed procedural schedule. The parties were unable to identify a procedural schedule that

would allow the Public Utility Commission of Texas to issue a final order within 180-days of the filing of the case and EPE requested a good cause exception.¹

The ALJ finds good cause and this request is **GRANTED**. The 180-day deadline is **EXTENDED** to **December 15, 2019**. Parties **SHALL** comply with the preliminary order and ensure a final order is processed to allow all deadlines to be met.
