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COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest and files this Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 21, 2019, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest), filed an application to amend water Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952, and to decertify portions of Aqua Texas Inc.'s service area in Montgomery County pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC) §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and the 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 to 24.237.

On January 3, 2020 the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 7 finding notice deficient and directing Quadvest to cure the deficiencies by January 24, 2020. The ALJ also established a deadline of 10 days from Quadvest filing of proof of completed notice with the Commission for Staff to file supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of notice. Quadvest filed supplemental information regarding notice on January 7, 2020.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

Staff has reviewed Quadvest's submitted proof of notice filed on September 19, 2019, December 11, 2019, and January 7, 2020 and recommends that it be found sufficient. Specifically, Quadvest filed proof showing that Montgomery County MUD 136 is inactive in TCEQ's database and has no address listed.
