**ORDER NO. 8
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Quadvest, L.P. On December 11, 2019, Quadvest filed a signed affidavit that notice was given via newspaper publication in the *Houston Chronicle dba Cypress Creek Mirror* on October 16 and 23, 2019. Additionally, Quadvest filed a signed affidavit attesting that the required notice was given to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities and affected parties on October 3, 2019.

In Order No. 7, the administrative law judge (ALJ) required Quadvest to provide notice to a neighboring entity that was not listed with its affidavit. On January 7, 2020, Quadvest filed supplemental information indicating the entity is inactive.

The ALJ finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule:
