



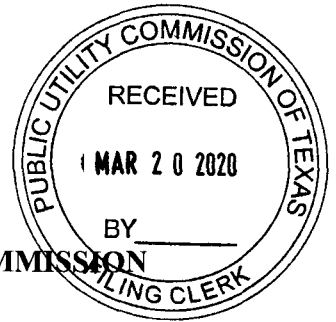

**ORDER NO. 9
GRANTING EXTENSION
AND ADDRESSING MOTION REGARDING SERVICE REQUIREMENTS**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's request for extension filed on March 18, 2020. Commission Staff stated that they are still waiting for a signed consent form from Aqua Texas, Inc. The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants the extension request. On or before April 8, 2020, Commission Staff must file its final recommendation.

Within the same filing, Commission Staff filed a motion to require service by electronic mail and to direct any party that has not previously provided an email address to file a notice informing the parties of the email address to be used for service. In light of the Commission's Order entered in Docket No. 50664,¹ Commission Staff's request to require electronic service is moot. The ALJ, however, requires any party who has not previously provided an email address for service of documents, to file in this docket no later than March 20, 2020 a notice specifying an email address for service of documents.
