(TWC) §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and the 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 to 24.237. The requested service area consists of approximately 208 acres. On March 31, 2020, the Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 9, establishing April 22, 2020 for parties to file joint findings of fact and conclusions of law.

II. MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for the filing of any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requests an extension to file to file joint findings of fact and conclusions of law until April 27, 2020.
