COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 1

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this, Staff's Response to Order No. 1. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 21, 2019, Ameenah Muhammad (complainant) filed a complaint against Forty200 Apartment Homes (Forty200) regarding charges for water service. This complaint was filed under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.242.

On May 23, 2019, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 1, which required Staff to file a statement of position by June 20, 2019. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STATEMENT OF POSITION

Order No. 1 gave Forty200 a deadline of June 11, 2019, to respond to the complaint. To this point in time, Forty200 has not filed a response. Staff has reached out to Forty200, but has been unable to make contact. Therefore, Staff is unable to formulate a position at this time.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that Forty200 be ordered to provide a response to the above complaint and set another deadline for Staff's statement of position.
