COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Commission Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this, Commission Staff's Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 21, 2019, Ameenah Muhammad (Complainant) filed a complaint against Forty200 Apartment Homes regarding charges for water services.

Order No. 4, issued August 27, 2019, set September 18, 2019, as the deadline for Staff to file its statement of position regarding the complaint. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. On August 21, 2019, Staff issued Requests for Information (RFIs) to the Complainant. The responses, which were due September 10, 2019, have not been submitted by the Complainant. Staff requires information contained in those RFI responses in order to draft a complete statement of position in this matter.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reason stated above, Staff respectfully requests that the presiding Administrative Law Judge issue an Order mandating the Complainant to respond to the RFIs within 10 days from the date of such Order, and that Staff be given two weeks from that date to file its statement of position.
