ORDER NO. 2 REQUIRING RESPONSES

On May 21, 2019, Ameenah Muhammad (complainant) filed a complaint against Forty200 Apartment Homes (Forty200) regarding charges for water services. In Order No. 1 the administrative law judge (ALJ) required Forty200 to file a response to the complaint. To date Forty200 has failed to file a response.

The ALJ requires Forty200 to file a response to the complaint by no later than July 8, 2019, per 16 TAC § 22.78. The response must address the following:

- 1. the Commission's jurisdiction over this proceeding;
- 2. allegations raised in the complaint;
- 3. applicable statutes, rules, orders, and tariff provisions;
- 4. copies of any rates or tariffs that are the subject of this complaint; and
- 5. any other matters relevant to the complaint.

Commission Staff must file a statement of position regarding the complaint by July 22, 2019. As part of the statement of position, Commission Staff will address whether the complainant complied with the requirements for informal resolution in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.242.
