**ORDER NO. 3
REQUIRING RESPONSES AND FINDING COMPLAINT COMPLIANT**

On May 21, 2019, Ameenah Muhammad (complainant) filed a complaint against Forty200 Apartment Homes (Forty200) regarding charges for water services.

I. Requiring Response

In Order No. 1 the administrative law judge (ALJ) required Forty200 to file a response to the complaint. In Order No. 2 the ALJ required Forty200 to file a response by July 8, 2019. To date Forty200 has failed to file a response.

The ALJ requires Forty200 to file a response to the complaint by no later than August 12, 2019, per 16 TAC § 22.78. The response must address the following:

1. the Commission's jurisdiction over this proceeding;
2. allegations raised in the complaint;
3. applicable statutes, rules, orders, and tariff provisions;
4. copies of any rates or tariffs that are the subject of this complaint; and
5. any other matters relevant to the complaint.

Commission Staff must file a statement of position regarding the complaint by August 26, 2019.


II. Finding the Complaint Compliant
