## ORDER NO. 4 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by the City of Hallsville. On October 7, 2019, the City filed the affidavit of Jesse Casey, Mayor, attesting that notice was provided to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on September 6, 2019. The City also filed the publisher's affidavit of Dianne Gray, classified representative of the *Marshall News Messenger*, attesting to publication of notice on September 10, 2019, and September 17, 2019.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline to Intervene	October 17, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent	December 16, 2019
Deadline for the applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	January 3, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	January 10, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	January 24, 2020
