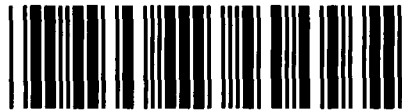

ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE; REQUIRING
NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of the City of Hallsville to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13200 and to decertify a portion of West Harrison Water Supply Corporation's CCN number 12728 in Harrison County.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the City of Hallsville to provide notice of the application, using the forms, and as described in the memorandum of Debbie Reyes, dated August 30, 2019.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Hallsville to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	October 18, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of Hallsville filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
