



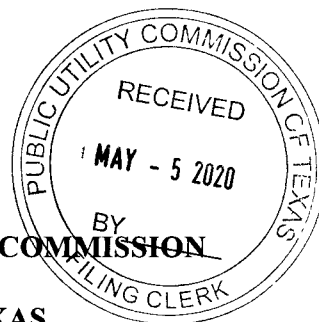

**ORDER NO. 7
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINING INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE; AND
RETYLING DOCKET**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application filed on May 23, 2019, by the City of Elmendorf for a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity. The City supplemented its application on March 25, 2020, to request additional certificated area in Wilson County.

The administrative law judge finds the application remains administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b). Additionally, the docket is restyled as to reflect the additional certificated area requested in Wilson County.


Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before June 4, 2020, the applicant must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Roshan Pokhrel and Fred Bednarski's May 4, 2020 memorandum, attached to Commission Staff's fifth supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed notice. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before July 3, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
