



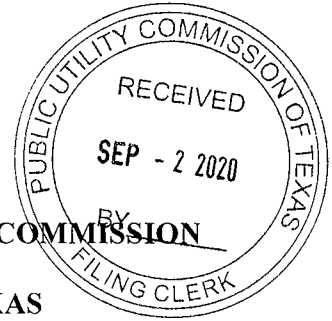

**ORDER NO. 9
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND;
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**


This Order addresses the application filed by the City of Elmendorf for a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Bexar and Wilson counties and the sufficiency of the notice. On August 13, 2020, Elmendorf filed the affidavit of Roxanne Deleon, city secretary, who attested that notice and a map was mailed on July 14, 2020, to neighboring utilities, counties, cites, and affected parties. On August 13, 2020, Elmendorf filed a publishers' affidavit attesting to the publication of notice on July 15 and 22, 2020, in the *Wilson County News*, a newspaper of general circulation in Wilson and Bexar counties. On September 1, 2020, Commission Staff recommended that the notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient. The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Elmendorf for review and consent	September 28, 2020
Deadline for Elmendorf to file signed consent forms with the Commission	October 12, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	October 19, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	October 26, 2020
