**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINING INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application filed on May 23, 2019, by the City of Elmendorf for a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Bexar County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).


Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before October 8, 2019, the applicant must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Debbie Reyes and Elisabeth English's August 28, 2019 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before November 8, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
