SOAH ORDER NO. 2 GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE AND REQUIRNG REVISED SCHEDULE

On June 17, 2019, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC filed an agreed proposed procedural schedule and a statement that it does not oppose the motion to intervene filed in this docket by the Gulf Coast Coalition of Cities (GCCC) on June 4, 2019. The parties propose that the hearing on the merits in this case convene on September 3, 2019. GCCC's motion to intervene is **GRANTED**.

The undersigned Administrative Law Judge, however, cannot convene a hearing on the merits on September 3, 2019. On June 12, 2019, Commission Staff filed a request for hearing. That puts this case on a 180-day timeline in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code § 25.182(d)(9)(E). Due to other conflicts, the ALJ does not have a sufficient opening to hear this case between August 7 and September 17, 2019. Assuming the parties do not want a hearing before September 2, 2019, the parties will need to propose a hearing that convenes after September 17, 2019, but which stays within the 180-day processing deadline. Before filing a revised procedural schedule, a party representative is urged to contact Erin Hurley, administrative assistant to the ALJ, at erin.hurley@soah.texas.gov to ensure that a proposed hearing date works. Accordingly, the parties shall confer and SHALL file a revised agreed procedural schedule that proposes a date for the hearing on the merits in this case after September 17, 2019.
