NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice of Approval addresses the petition of Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC for a transmission cost recovery factor (TCRF) update. The Commission approves Oncor’s TCRF update.

I. Findings of Fact

The Commission makes the following findings of fact.

Petitioner

1. Oncor provides delivery service in the Electric Reliability Council of Texas region.

Petition

2. On May 31, 2019, Oncor filed a petition to update its TCRF, effective for billings on and after September 1, 2019.
3. Oncor seeks approval of an adjustment to its TCRF rider for changes in wholesale transmission rates approved or allowed by the Commission for wholesale transmission providers.
4. Oncor seeks approval of the updated TCRF charges shown in column (h) of attachment A to the petition.
5. In Order No. 2 issued on June 18, 2019, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the petition sufficient.

Eligibility for TCRF Update

6. Oncor’s last TCRF update was approved January 14, 2019, in Docket No. 48930.¹
7. This petition is Oncor’s first requested TCRF update filed in 2019.

Notice

8. On June 4, 2019, Oncor filed the affidavit of J. Michael Sherburne, Vice President, who attested that notice was provided on May 31, 2019 to all retail electric providers as posted on the Commission's website.
9. In Order No. 2 issued on June 18, 2019, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the notice sufficient.

Evidence

10. On July 10, 2019, Commission Staff and Oncor filed a joint motion to admit evidence.
11. In Order No. 3 issued on July 15, 2019, the ALJ admitted the following evidence into the record: (a) Oncor's petition and all attachments filed on May 31, 2019; (b) Oncor's affidavit attesting to the provision of notice filed on June 4, 2019; and (c) Commission Staff's final recommendation and all attachments filed on July 3, 2019.

Informal Disposition

12. More than 15 days have passed since completion of the notice provided in this docket.
13. Commission Staff and Oncor are the only parties to this proceeding.
14. No party requested a hearing and no hearing is necessary.
15. The decision is not adverse to any party.
16. Commission Staff recommended approval of the petition.

II. Conclusions of Law

The Commission makes the following conclusions of law.

1. Oncor is an electric utility as defined in PURA² §§ 11.004(1) and 31.002(6).
2. The Commission has jurisdiction over this petition under PURA §§ 32.001 and 32.101.
3. Oncor provided notice of the petition in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.55.
4. The Commission processed the petition in accordance with the requirements of PURA and Commission rules.

5. Oncor is authorized to update its TCRF on March 1 and September 1 of each year under 16 TAC § 25.193(b).
6. The petition does not constitute a major rate proceeding as defined in 16 TAC § 22.2(27).
7. The petition meets the requirements for informal disposition in 16 TAC § 22.35.

III. Ordering Paragraphs

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following orders:

1. The Commission approves Oncor's TCRF update.
2. The Commission amends Oncor's Tariff Rate Schedule, 6.1.1.6.1 – Rider TCRF, effective for billings on and after September 1, 2019.
3. Within 10 days of the date of this Notice, Oncor must file a clean record copy of Tariff Rate Schedules, 6.1.1.6.1 – Rider TCRF, with the proper effective date, with Central Records to stamp and mark *Approved* and be kept in the Commission's tariff book.
4. The Commission denies all other motions and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted in this Notice.
